Our History

To address the issue of pharmacy deserts in Milwaukee, Hashim Zaibak founded Hayat Pharmacy in 2011, with the goal of ensuring access to quality health services for diverse communities in and around the inner city. Today Zaibak and Hayat co-owner and President Tamir Kaloti operate 19 pharmacies in Southeast Wisconsin. The organization combines innovative technology solutions and personalized care to meet the healthcare needs of thousands of enrolled patients in the communities it serves. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Hayat became a leading COVID response provider for Wisconsin.



Patient-centered care is at the heart of what we do.

The pharmacy created Hayat Cares community health presentations to educate the local community about leading health issues, such as diabetes and heart disease. The presentations are offered off-site at assisted living communities, workplaces, food pantries and places of worship, to help people better navigate their health.



Our COVID-19 Vaccine and Treatment Impact

During the COVID-19 pandemic, Hayat Pharmacy recognized the importance of widespread immunization for our area's most vulnerable populations, including older adults and those who have underlying medical conditions.

Through our coordinated vaccination programs of in-pharmacy services, on- and off-site clinics and athome vaccinations, we contributed to safeguarding the health and well-being of our communities by administering 106,000 COVID-19 vaccines and are still counting. We remain dedicated to removing barriers to healthcare access and continue to prioritize the needs of vulnerable populations.

Our COVID-19 Testing Impact

Testing for COVID-19 and communicating with the public about why, when and how to test, and what to do if a result was positive, were key for reducing the spread of the coronavirus. To meet the statewide need for testing early on, Hayat Pharmacy established two drive-thru testing sites in Milwaukee (on North Ave. and Layton Ave.) in partnership with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Wisconsin Department of Health Services and McKesson.

Our convenient COVID testing services enabled people to test quickly after exposure and secure proof of a negative test for work or travel requirements. As cases surged in Milwaukee, testing reached its highest demand in late 2021. We responded by expanding our operating hours and workforce to offer testing 24-hours a day, seven days a week starting January 1, 2022. We maintained these hours into spring 2023 to help remove barriers and maximize community testing access.

Creating Greater Access

During the pandemic, Hayat Pharmacy coordinated an extensive COVID-19 community outreach initiative to increase awareness of and ensure access to COVID vaccines for vulnerable populations of all ages throughout Southeast Wisconsin. Our collaboration with community organizations was pivotal in fostering trust and addressing specific needs within each community.

By partnering with senior centers and senior living facilities, we tailored our approach to reach elderly populations who faced higher risks. Likewise, our engagement with faith-based organizations and food pantries allowed us to provide vaccinations in familiar and trusted settings. Through these partnerships, we not only administered vaccinations, but also delivered critical COVID-19 education and support, empowering communities to make informed decisions about their health.

- 50,000+ bottles of hand sanitizer




Baby Formula and Diaper Community Relief

A Message From Hayat Leadership

When COVID-19 arrived in Wisconsin in February 2020, health care sectors across the state were soon activated to fight this highly contagious and dangerous disease. Because pharmacists are some of the nation's most accessible health care providers, they quickly became designated as essential frontline health and safety workers during the pandemic in our state and across the nation.

As a locally owned and operated organization in Milwaukee, we felt Hayat Pharmacy was well-positioned to help address the health crisis in our state early on and ensure a continuum of quality patient care for our core services. We committed to focusing our resources in ways that would best support priority pandemic responses to help people in the neighborhoods we serve. We coordinated our workforce across our nineteen locations in Southeast Wisconsin and worked closely with other service providers, state agencies and community organizations to prevent the spread of the then-new coronavirus, later named SARS-CoV-2.

Shortly after Wisconsin's initial rollout of COVID-19 vaccines for health workers in mid-December 2020, we administered our first COVID vaccine in January 2021. To meet the needs of working families, the clinic operated seven days a week and offered extended evening hours.

Meeting people where they are has always been a Hayat priority. To reach homebound individuals, those with complex medical conditions, and other high-risk patients, we mobilized our registered nurses and pharmacists for in-home COVID vaccines, testing and treatments. Overall, more than 106,000 vaccines were administered in our pharmacies, at our on- and off-site clinics and in the comfort of patients' homes.

COVID-19 testing was a priority to prevent the spread of the virus and keep communities functioning. We designated locations on Milwaukee's north and south side as free drive-thru testing sites in partnership with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Wisconsin Department of Health Services and McKesson. During the peak of the COVID testing demand in 2022, we offered drive-up testing services 24-hours a day, seven days a week for five consecutive months. In total, we administered more than 80,000 COVID-19 tests.

We exist to serve and protect the health of our communities. Only together will we ensure the overall well-being of our community and our preparedness and capacity for meeting the specific future health needs of Wisconsinites. To all of our partners, we thank you. We invite you to connect with us to explore additional ways to realize a healthier tomorrow. Collaboration is key moving forward.
